Join us the first day of summer, 21 June 2006, when we open two new exhibitions for the upcoming season. When Hangover Becomes Form is a collaborative installation project featuring Toronto-based artist Scott Lyall and New York-based artist Rachel Harrison and curated by art critic and scholar Dan Adler. Hangover offers a misbehaving mix of thematic, historical, and visual references that marks the first time either artist has ever collaborated and is the first time Harrison's work will be shown in Los Angeles. The second project, is titled after one of LaMonte Young's well known performance scores, Draw a straight line and follow it. This exhibition traces works from George Brecht, Jackson Maclow, Yoko Ono, Mieko Shiomi, Robert Watts and others to a contemporary generation of LA-based artists. Each Draw participant was invited to explore the Jean Brown Fluxus archive at the Getty Research Institute to pick a score to instigate a new work—producing art objects, installations and performances (planned and spontaneous) throughout the summer at LACE.

Created for LACE's 27th Annual Art Auction Benifit, *Flourish* is a performance that yields a limited edition of art objects. During the course of the evening, guests will first be given one of five individually designed auction paddles for use during the art bidding. After which, each guest can drop their paddle off at the *Flourish* table to be transformed into an ikebana sculpture. As with many of Kimmel's site-specific performances, Flourish examines the ideas of multi use, purpose and exchange. Her work focuses on potential and the narrative language and framework inherent in social events.


